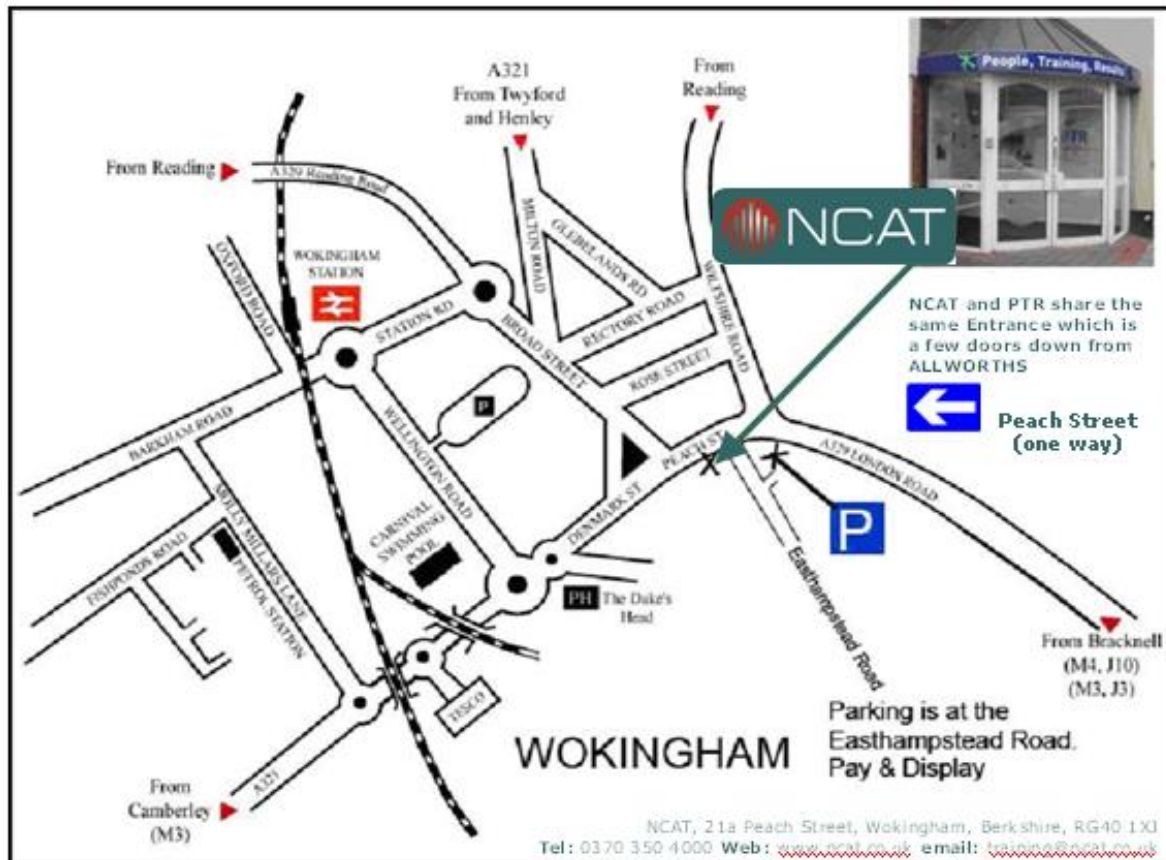


Map, Directions and Accommodation



Directions by RAIL

There are direct trains from London Waterloo you need the Reading service. When you arrive at Wokingham station it is about 10 minutes walk

You can also get to Wokingham from Paddington, London via Reading. When at Reading go to platform 4a. Every train that leaves this platform stops at Wokingham. There is always a train waiting to go on this platform.

From Wokingham Train Station

Turn left on to Station Road, cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and follow until you get to the T-junction at the end of this road. You will see the Hope & Anchor public house to your left and the Queens Head in front of you. Turn right here and walk into the Town Centre. You are now in Broad Street. Keep going and you will notice the Post Office on your right and shortly afterwards Zizi's Italian restaurant on your left. Continuing on this road you will see Boots on your left and the old town hall on your right. Ahead of you is Barclays Bank. Carry straight on and Cross the road in front of Barclays Bank. Now turn left down Peach Street. Continue past Subway to your right, and then the Cornish Pasty Company. Finally just as you past

Julian Graves you will see a conservatory style set of doors. Please press the intercom button and we will let you in.

You can also travel via London Paddington Station. If you get the fast track train from Paddington the first stop is Reading. This is usually a 25 minute journey. At Reading then go to platform 4a (near the exit) There should be a training waiting to leave. There are several services you can use to get to Wokingham, Reading to Waterloo, Reading to Guildford and Reading to Gatwick, all stop at Wokingham. The journey time from Reading to Wokingham is not more than 10 minutes.

Directions by ROAD

From The M4

Turn off the M4 at (Junction 10) onto the A329M and head towards Bracknell & Wokingham. You need to take the first exit off and turn right under the fly-over towards Wokingham on the London Road. When you join the one-way system, stay in the left hand lane. This is Peach Street. Take second left turning into Easthampstead Road (**GPS, Postcode - RG40 2EG**). The car park is first left and is £4.00 per day.

Leaving your car, turn right out of the car park and left into Peach Street, and you should see Marks & Spencer on your right. Passing Allworths on your left, in front of you, you will see a conservatory-style set of doors illustrated above. Please press the intercom button and we will let you in.

From The M3 London

Turn off the M3 at (Junction 3) onto the A322 and head towards Bracknell. At the second roundabout (you will see a big sign for Coral Reef), turn left onto the B3430. Your GPS should re calculate the route at this point. About 2 miles later you will come to another roundabout, go straight across. Keep going down the B3430, you will pass a small roundabout (TRL) then on the second roundabout turn right. About 1 mile down the road you want the first turning on the left. This is the start of the Easthampstead Road; follow this road for a few miles, across a level crossing. As you come into Wokingham the car park is on the **right hand side (GPS, Postcode - RG40 2EG)**. This car park is £4.00 per day.

From The M3 Southampton

Turn off at Junction 4a, and go down the A327 for a few miles. You will come to a roundabout, turn Right. Then onto a second roundabout, go straight across. Follow the road down for about 1.5 miles then at the next roundabout turn Left then almost immediately take the first turning on the Right. Go down this for a few miles and then turn Left onto the A321. After about 2 miles go straight across the first roundabout. Then you will come to the second (double) roundabout; turn Right onto the B3430 (Your GPS should take you this way). Turn Left at the first set of traffic lights. Follow the road down and turn Left onto the Easthampstead Road. Go across a level crossing. As you come into Wokingham the car park is on the **right hand side (GPS, Postcode - RG40 2EG)**. This car park is £4.00 per day.

Leaving your car, turn right out of the car park and left into Peach Street, and you should see Marks & Spencer on your right. Passing Allworths on your left, in front of you, you will see a conservatory-style set of doors illustrated above. Please press the intercom button and we will let you in.
